India won the toss and opted to bowl first. Bangladesh openers Liton Das and Mehidy Hasan(32 runs of 59 balls) provided a solid start for the team and they built a partnership of 120 runs and at one stage they were easily looking for a total of 250+ runs on the board, unfortunately after losing the 1st wickets, they lost the plot also and only Liton Das could stay at the crease and scored a brilliant century in the Asia Cup 2018 final match. Other batsman could not score enough as Bangladesh folded out for 222 runs only.

In the chase in-form opening duo of India captain Rohit Sharma and leading run scorer of Asia Cup 2018 Shikhar Dhawan couldn't provide big partnership as Dhawan got out on 15 runs only. Rohit Sharma was the highest run scorer with 48 runs in 55 balls. Tight bowling from Bangladesh didn't allow Indian batmen to accelerate the run rate and they took important wickets at crucial time also; they were in the game till the last ball of the match being bold. Kedar Jadhav (23 runs) took the final run from the last ball of the match to give India a memorable win and thus India beat Bangladesh by 3 wickets to lift the Asia Cup trophy 7th times, record the most by any team.
